- For arming/disarming the Secvest 2WAY and Terxon alarm systems
- Easy to operate without entering a code – never “forget your PIN code” again
- Simply hold in front of the alarm panel or control panel
- Functions on a completely contact-free basis
- Several chip keys can be used with an alarm system (depending on the alarm panel)

The proximity key is an optional accessory for contact-free arming and disarming of alarm panels, replacing code entry.

Easy operation:

To arm or disarm the system, you just hold the chip in front of the alarm panel or control panel. The user no longer needs to remember a PIN code, and this makes authorization (authentication) on the system much easier. It is used for easy, convenient arming and disarming of the ABUS alarm systems Secvest 2WAY and Terxon.

How it works:

Using proximity technology, the inductor integrated in the key transmits the respective code when it is brought near the receiver. This means that the user can be uniquely authenticated practically as they walk by – without it being necessary for them to enter a PIN or pass the key through a reader. The radio field of the receiver provides the voltage to the proximity key for the code transmission – the key thus functions without its own battery.

Installation and programming:

The chip key is trained into the alarm panel (registered there electronically); the authorization is then programmed directly at the alarm panel.
