# Floor Marking Benefits



Read on to find our suggestions for effective floor marking



Use consistent, colour-coded floor marking in your workplace to mark out areas for lanes as well as specific areas for materials, pallets and working areas – it will increase safety & efficiency.



With a clear colour coded system, you can associate certain colours with certain tasks or areas in your factory or warehouse. Colour coding allows you to effectively move around the facility to complete your important tasks and find what you are looking for in good time.



By marking out areas in certain colours – you can associate paint or other tape on carts, for example – this way, staff easily associate the cart with its intended location.

# Floor Marking Benefits



Improve safety by making staff aware of colour coded areas. EG, black/yellow coded floor tape and paint mean you can easily warn of hazardous areas, equipment or traffic. Clearly mark Emergency Exits and escape routes in green.



Mark lanes/pathways: Emphasise and clearly mark the safest pathway to walk through. This helps to keep pedestrians and vehicles, and drivers safe.



Highlight hazards: Hazards should be marked with bright colours (for example red, orange or yellow.)

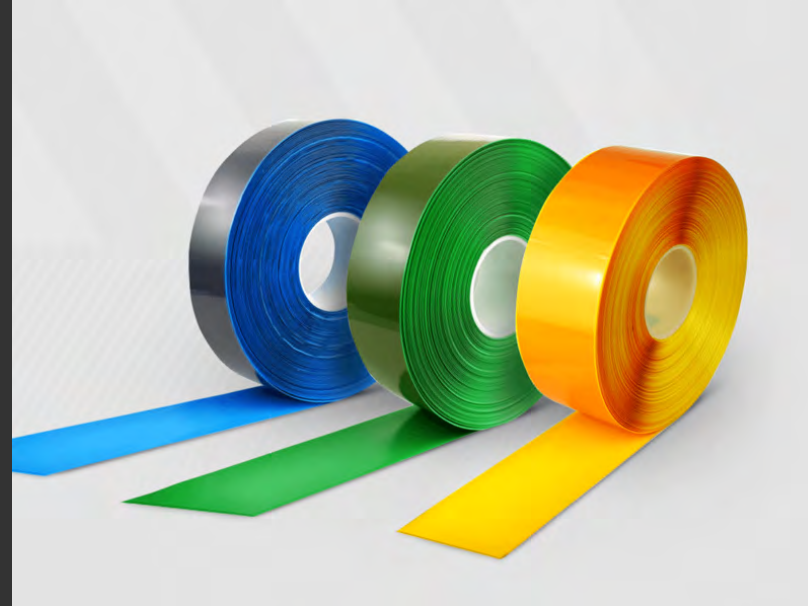
# Effective floor marking: tips



Here are a list of suggestions that can help you with how to use your RND floor marking, based on best practices



Colour-code storage fixtures, for example, to identify finished goods and raw materials. Colour code non-storage fixtures in a different colour.



Reduce confusion: Use as few colours as possible for marking your areas. Keep it simple.



Colour-code "keep clear" areas. For example, in front of safety equipment, defibrillators and fire extinguishers to keep the area clear.

# Effective floor marking: tips



Colour-code hazardous areas or equipment. Choose a colour or pattern to indicate the hazard, EG black/yellow stripes or chevrons. Also mark safety equipment and safety signage in the workplace in the same colours for easy recognition.



Colour-code work cell and equipment borders. Try colour coding the equipment and its aisle/location in the same colours.



Mark means of egress. You can use luminous egress path markings on pathways, steps and emergency exits . Consider using an Anti Slip tape for this.



Floor marking and signs help draw attention to the safe distancing rules. They provide visual cues to tell someone how far away they should be from someone else. Implementing good social distancing policies starts with organization and proactive action using safety as a focal point.
